As we prepare for the Ethanol Supply Year (ESY) 2025-26, we respectfully urge you to initiate early dialogue with industry stakeholders to collectively identify areas for improvement and implement measures that will enhance supply chain efficiency, ensuring smooth operations without disruptions.

We would also like to bring to your kind attention that the introduction of Surplus FCI Grain (SFG) under Tender C-3 has not yielded the anticipated outcomes.

In view of the upcoming ESY, should the usage of Surplus FCI Grain continue, we humbly submit the following suggestions for your consideration:

1. The availability of SFG may kindly be published in a timely manner under Tender C-1 itself for ESY 2025-26.
2. The available quantity of SFG may be considered for pro-rata allocation among all applicants, based on their respective applied quantities.

Considering the time-sensitive nature of these arrangements, we request your kind attention and look forward to a prompt and positive response.
